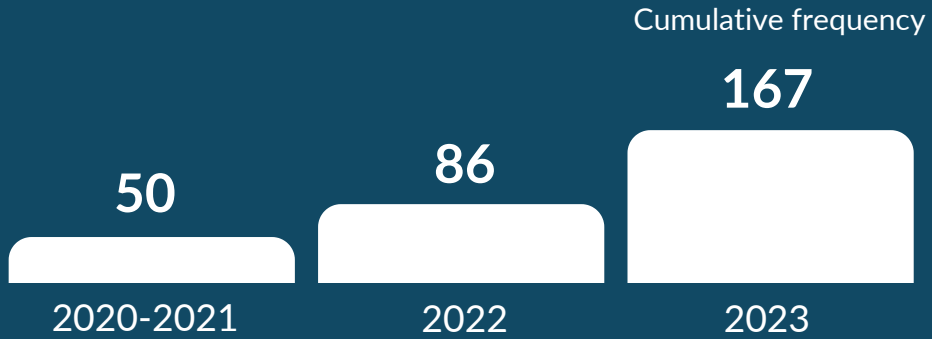

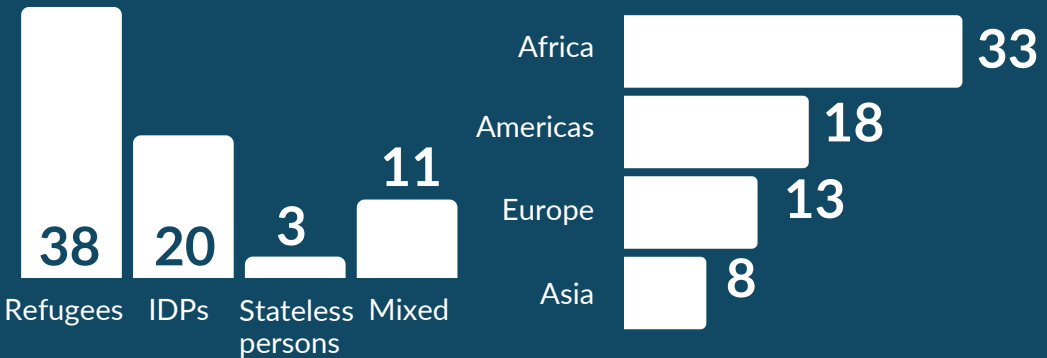
Global Annual Inclusion

What is the GAIN survey?

The EGRISS Global Annual Inclusion Survey (GAIN) monitors statistical projects related to refugees, those in need of international protection, internally displaced persons, and statelessness in national data systems and/or using the International Recommendations on Refugee (IRRS), IDPs (IRIS) Statelessness Statistics (IROSS).

It enables the EGRISS to:

- Monitor the use of the International Statistical Recommendations
- Identify challenges countries face, facilitating peer-to-peer learning
- Inform upcoming priorities and future revisions of the international recommendations.
