

TSG1–AFRICA Objectives

- Give visibility to the work on displacement and statelessness statistics by country, regional, international and other data actors in the region.
- Promote the mainstreaming of displacement and statelessness statistics through continental/regional engagement, including through migration and population statistics platforms.
- Promote capacity development activities to implement the IRRS, IRIS and IROSS recommendations at regional and country level, informed by the methodologies and tools provided by EGRISS.
- Reinforce a collaborative approach to improving displacement and statelessness statistics.

Geographic Scope: UNECA Countries
