TSG1-EUR Objectives

- Give visibility to the work on displacement and statelessness statistics by country, regional, international and other data actors in the region.
- Promote the mainstreaming of displacement and statelessness statistics through continental/regional engagement, including through migration and population statistics platforms.
- Promote capacity development activities to implement the IRRS, IRIS and IROSS recommendations at regional and country level, informed by the methodologies and tools provided by EGRISS.
- Reinforce a collaborative approach to improving displacement and statelessness statistics.

Geographic Scope: <u>UNECE Countries</u> (Member States)

The regional task teams of EGRISS' Technical Subgroup 1 (<u>Regional Engagement & Capacity Development</u>) follow the UN Economic Commissions' designations: Africa; Asia and Pacific; Europe; Latin America and the Caribbean; Western Asia. The focus of this TSG1 regional task team is Europe.
